For the third time this month I was overcharged at my local pharmacy for goods that I had purchased. Three times this month I went in to catch a sale they were having – one of those Buy One, Get One deals. For one of the deals I had a coupon as well, though I am by no means an extreme coupon user, storing up goods that I may or may not use or need in my personal warehouse just because I can.

I am not a shopper, but do like to save money on the things that I do purchase. Thus, I went in to get my deals. The deals would eventually materialize, but the trip itself turned into a half hour venture for four cans of whole, unsalted almonds, some granola and milk, all of which were on sale.

This, quite frankly, is beyond my break point for value. I was saving about \$15 on these three items, but it was just not worth the frustration of having to stand across a counter watching two fully grown adults try to figure out the deal that THEY were offering because it would not ring up right. Besides, a half hour ago, I had fifteen minutes to drive five minutes to work. I was now late.

To make matters worse, every time I had this issue it was the same cashier. Every time I was overcharged and had to stand and wait for these great periods of time, it was because of this one person. He just didn't seem to get it. On one of the occasions I had to actually explain the discrepancy to this man and I don't know the first thing about running their operation.

Of course, all of these thoughts came to me and the frustration built and the near-anger ensued before the time when I found out that this fellow was new. He was an older gentleman forced to go back to work by the poor economy and he was having a hard time learning a computer skill set. It was hard, he revealed to me, since the one computer that he did own was over ten years old and he thought maybe he used it twice.

Now, though I had never been rude or acted impatient in any way while these incidents occurred, I had a new understanding of the problem. In such understanding the calmness I displayed and the patience I mustered were not merely faces I donned for the moment, but genuine and informed. As I stood in line this morning behind a woman, whose order he had messed up, and watched his and her frustration, I prayed that he was doing better and would find success. Even though I was late, again, because of his missteps at the cash register, I didn't mind.

It is so easy to act without understanding. I would imagine that most of the times we get angry, jealous, hurt, envious, fearful, anxious or react in some emotional or overly-emotional way, it is due, in part, to a lack of understanding on our part. We are simply missing some piece, large or small, of the necessary information that we need to have a proper reaction. Many have this same inclination when it comes to practical spiritual matters. They act, but it is not according to understand, but unrestrained emotion.

In this day, let passion fill your heart and let understanding rule both.

Trust. Hmmm. Trust...the word was rolling around in my mind when I woke up this morning. Such a simple word, but it can be the hardest thing to do.

the One Year Bible Reading It was easier to trust as a child than as an adult, for me. As a kid, I trusted that my at best friend would never hurt me (I found out that wasn't true). I trusted that what my teacher said was ALWAYS right (found out that wasn't true either). The list could go on, but as we know, as time goes on the list of things that we CANNOT trust...grows.

> We live in a world full of sin. Satan has made sure that we don't feel comfortable trusting in things. He has made sure that we trust things that we can see more than things that we cannot see. If we can see it, we can believe it right? That's one of Satan's many lies.



This brings me back to this morning. Trust...trusting God. The problem that I was having was that I think sometimes we trust that God will do something because it is our conviction that he said he would, but the problem is that we might have misunderstood the promise.

Many times when we read the Bible we do it with an objective in mind, which can cloud our interpretation of what God actually meant. Matthew 6:25-34 is a good example. Jesus is talking about the fact that we do not need to worry because God will take care of our needs. Does that mean that we do not have to plan or that don't have to work because God will provide? No - God expects to be good stewards. But one could look at these texts and hope that it means that we will never have trouble because Jesus said not to worry.

So, can we trust God? We know in our hearts that answer to that question. Just make sure that you ask for the Holy Spirit to guide you as you search the scriptures for answers or as you pray for guidance in your life.

If we can trust NOTHING else, we can always trust God to have our eternal salvation in mind.
