1. Pishon, Gihon, Tigris and Euphrates
2. Adam (Genesis 2:23, 24)
3. Lamech (Genesis 4:19)
4. Cain – He must “rule over it” (Gen. 4:7)
5. Noah’s because “this one shall bring relief from our work and from the painful toil of our hands” (Gen. 5:29)
6. 150 days (Gen. 7:24)
7. Raven and a dove; to see if the waters had receded; the raven went “to and fro until the waters were dried up” and the dove was sent out three times – first time came back having found no place to rest; second with an olive branch; third, did not return at all. (Gen. 8:6-12)
8. The covenant was made with “Noah, all his offspring, every living creature...” (Gen. 9:8-11)
9. Shem (Gen. 9:25-28)
10. Nimrod (Gen. 10:8)
11. Babel means “confused language” (Gen. 11:9)
12. Abram’s brothers are Nahor and Haran; His father was Terah (Gen. 11:26)
13. Rise early and offer burnt offering for his children in case they had sinned (1:5)
14. “There is none like him on the earth, a blameless upright man, who fears God and turns away from evil” (1:8)
15. None. Job is unaware of the conversation. Satan talks twice with God (Ch. 1 & 2)
16. Satan was not allowed to kill Job (2:6)
17. Seven days and seven nights (2:13)
18. He wished he was never born (3:3)
19. Neither famine or sword or war or destruction come to the innocent (5:19-22), but the wickedness are snared in the deceit, meet darkness during the day and are caught in their own craftiness (5:12-14)
20. Gives rain on the earth, send water on the fields, sets on high the lowly, and brings the mourning to safety... (5:9ff)
21. A wild donkey braying when he has food; the ox over his fodder; the tasteless food eaten without salt; a hired hand that looks for his wages; months of emptiness; nights of misery; a cloud that fades and vanishes
22. Repent (8:5-7)
23. Swifter than a runner; like skiffs of reed (9:25, 26); like a flower; like a shadow (14:2)
24. To let him know why He contends with Job (10:2)
25. Prepare his heart, stretch out his hands toward God, put iniquity far away, and let not injustice dwell in his tents (11:13-15)
26. God has done it (12:9) Job suggests his friends go “ask the beast...birds..fish” (12:7,8). Job is mocking his friends for their ignorance.
27. Worthless physicians (13:4)
28. “Though he slay me, I will hope in him; yet I will argue my ways to his face” (13:15)
29. Eliphaz says Job does not fear the Lord (15:4)
30. Miserable comforters (16:2)
