Over the last five years I have had to alter or completely change how I bank. It all started when I noticed some charges to my account that I knew were not mine. While my family and I were away at a Christian youth camp, someone from Miami paid for \$500 worth of GPS cards using my account information. On another occasion money had been taken from my account by a company I had never heard of who claimed to have delivered a product at my request, though the product was never received and I had never authorized any of it.

Now, the bank, because they are insured for such things, gave my money back once I filed enough paperwork to fill a rather large folder and they investigated to make sure my claims of illegitimacy were accurate. Yet, it was still a pain because I now had to change all of my accounts, which meant that I had to get new cards, new checks and then call all the companies that I legitimately deal with and alter the account information. I was robbed of not only money, but precious time and energy. These I would Ed never get back.

There is, however, one bank where I have never had such problems and never will. Well, it is not a bank per se. In fact it is not even located in this world, but it is the place where I store the real treasures of life. Each day I make every attempt to deposit in this account the returns I get by living fully immersed in Christ. Each and every day, when I exercise godliness, grow and win souls for Christ I make deposits into this account. Though I do not earn my salvation by them these things that make life sweet...that are the best things this life has to offer...things like peace and hope and love...are reserved for me and can never be taken from me. Oh! I may surrender them or let go of them, but there is no foe or friend that can in clandestine fashion break into this vault of God and take away this joy. There is no hacker that can crack God's code. It is absolutely and ultimately safe, just as I am when I put my trust fully in Him.

Where have you placed your treasure? Have you put them in a safety deposit box? It can be stolen. Maybe you locked them in a safe in the bottom of some dark closet somewhere? It can be destroyed. Maybe you have no idea what true treasure is beyond the sorrowful, shallow thinking that would include the Lexus in your driveway or the pool in your backyard or some artwork or signed memorabilia or stocks. In this day, lay your true treasure up in heaven so none may rob you of ultimate joy, your purpose or meaning.
