

"And if anyone will not receive you or listen to your words, shake off the dust from your feet when you leave that house or town."

Matthew 10:13, 14

Coexist? Have you seen those bumper stickers? They have been around for some time, emblazoned on the back of various vehicles, as if they were some badge of the peacemaker who desires nothing more than to get along with their neighbors. Lately, however, the word has found it's way into conversation and the news.

We have been warned left and right not about a similar attack, but against any kind of backlash against those who espouse a slightly different version of the doctrines that lead to the killing of those journalists in France and similar attacks in our own country in Boston, Texas and other places. We should not be "Islamaphobic," but rather embrace the peaceful Islam and coexist, is the cry.

There are, of course, several issues with this idea. The first and most obvious issue is the fact that Islam is not a peaceful religion, but from its inception has forced a burden upon the world of acceptance in various degrees. This acceptance is not simply tolerance, but what amounts to an admission of faith in Islam through sharia laws about conversion, confession and blaspheme. All men are required to show reverence to the prophet Muhammad and never speak anything that might seem to detract from what amounts to his pseudo-divinity. When one does not surrender to such precepts then physical force is manifest by the more radical elements.

The second problem takes the first point to a deeper level. When most people say coexist they mean that truth is unimportant as long as we are not arguing. Coexist then becomes the enemy of the quest for truth. If my system of faith cannot be scrutinized from external sources, whether I am Islamic, Christian, Wiccan or atheist, then it would seem deficient. I don't want to believe in a system of faith that cannot be reasonably examined. I may fail, as have others, and examination of my life will always result in exposing a failure, but my faith must stand up to scrutiny or fall flat and be rendered unworthy.

Having said that, let me ask how many of those faiths whose symbols are represented in the whole coexist idea, are willing to be examined and answer the hard questions. Some will. Some, like Islam, however, will not even allow the questions. Who was this Mohammad and when did his whole movement begin? Does his teaching stand up to the various tests that may be administered to it concerning inspiration or it's origins with God? I will let the follower of Islam answer these, but suspect that we will find the same thing we find with most "religions" we are simply supposed to accept without examination – manmade constructs and fallible fodder from eclectic sources unrelated to
