

Proving the Bible

Proving whether something is true or not is called apologetics. This word is derived from the Greek word "apologia," which means "to defend." After all, if the Bible is not true or if it is filled with errors, Christianity would only be a "blind faith"—something people believe without any evidence to support it.

However, Christianity is *not* a blind faith. It is the *only* religion that can prove itself, and a main source of that proof is the Bible. Although it is becoming less common, there are still people who tell others that they follow Christianity "because it feels right" (or use wording like that). This is unfortunate, since there is a lot of evidence supporting Christianity. Why one would not take advantage of the overwhelming evidence is beyond me. Just about every discipline of study can offer something toward the proving of the Bible. Among the greatest of these are archeology and biology. What we have expected to find both within us and within the world affirm over and over the truth and accuracy of scripture. These are too abundant to list in an article of this nature

However, I do want you to think of another type of "evidence" for the validity of the Bible – the lack of evidence against it. You see a lot of folks claim that the Bible is just some ancient corrupted book that is really nothing more than the writings of some ancient men that may give a great sense of morality, but offer little else. To prove this they suggest that it is inaccurate, corrupted and biased beyond what we might consider reasonable. The problem with this assertion, however, is that it has never been proven. When evidence is offered for the
